Evacuation Items Checklist

Money

- Blank checks
- Cash
- Check books
- Credit cards
- Savings books

Medications

- Analgesics
- First-aid kit
- Motion sickness tablets
- Prescription dentures
- Prescription glasses
- Prescription hearing aids
- Prescriptions

Jewelry

- Decorations, pins, awards
- Family heirlooms
- Gold, silver, and other valuable jewelry

Food and Water (for three to seven days - if time permits)

- Manual can opener
- Non-perishable, ready-to-eat food
- Pet food
- Pet treats
- Water (at least one gallon per person and pet per day)

Clothing (appropriate for the season - if time permits)

- Change of clothing for each person (for one to seven days)
- Change of underwear
- Coats and jackets
- Gloves and scarves
- Hats and caps
- Infant supplies and toys
- Shoes and boots
- Sleepwear

Additional Items (if time permits)

- Cameras and extra batteries
- Cell phones
- Covered container to use as an emergency toilet
- Flashlights and extra batteries
- Portable radio and extra batteries
- Reading material
- Recreational items
